Dr. Maurice Bunnell is currently working for the Connecticut Department of Corrections. He obtained his DNP at Quinnipiac University and his MSN from Yale University School of Nursing. Maurice began his nursing education at Quinnipiac College in 1973. His clinical specialty is behavioral-mental health nursing and working with the underserved and marginalized populations.

He is an ANCC board certified as a Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner and an Adult Nurse Practitioner. During his career he has worked in a variety of settings including orthopaedics, otolaryngology, plastic and reconstructive surgery, cardio-thoracic ICU, a researcher on the phrenic pacemaker team, and nursing analyst for the first electronic health record implementation at Yale-New Haven Hospital. Dr. Bunnell was also a clinician in a methadone clinic and a detox unit for opioids, alcohol and benzodiazepines.
