

Biosketch: Millie Hepburn PhD, RN, ACNS-BC, SCRN

Dr. Millie Hepburn is an Assistant Professor of Nursing at Pace University School of Nursing and a Part time Professor of Nursing at Quinnipiac University. She obtained her PhD at Seton Hall University in NJ, as well as Master's Degrees from Columbia University, NY and Bloomsburg University. Her clinical & research specialty is the care and prevention of Stroke and other Neuroscience conditions as well as Neurologic Rehabilitation.

She is certified as an Adult Clinical Nurse Specialist, and has a specialty certification in stroke care. Dr. Hepburn has also provided oversight and developed professional competencies for inpatient psychiatric care of patients with addiction at both NYU Langone Hospital and Columbia University Medical Center in New York. As a component of her current role, she has developed novel simulations to foster her students' understanding of the unique humanistic needs for patients and families of patients struggling with addiction, and to negate the stigma often associated with their care, especially in emergency room settings.
