Michael Hines is currently the Assistant Director of Bail Services and Adult Probation for the Judicial Branch – Court Support Services Division (JB-CSSD). He oversees the supervision of more than 100 employees in the five regions throughout the state as well as within the Central Office in Wethersfield. He has extensive experience in all areas of pretrial supervision and post-conviction probation policies, procedures and statutes. In his capacity as Assistant Director, he also oversees the Bail Services Unit, (including the Jail Re-Interview and Alcohol Education Programs), Adult Probation Specialized caseloads, including the Sex Offender Unit.

Mr. Hines began his career in 1989 as a Bail Commissioner in the Bristol Court. He also held the positions in the Judicial Branch for over 29 years including the Bail Commission Statewide Night Supervisor, Special Sessions Court Supervisor for Bail Services, Jail Re-Interview Project Manager working with pretrial clients who were jail bound, and the Statewide Intake, Assessment, and Referral (IAR) Program Manager monitoring IAR procedures and services. Prior to his promotion to his current position he was one of the Regional Managers of Adult Probation.
